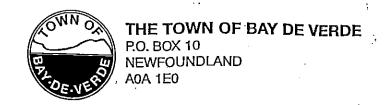

REPORT:

On Tuesday, January 15th, 2013, maintenance representative from Harvey and Company Limited carried out 100 hour inspection work on the JCB Backhoe as per terms of agreement to purchase.

Work included: Repairs to windshield

Wiper: {checking to see if problem is with the switch or motor.}

Hydraulic leak fixed

500 hour major inspection will include transmission, gear oil, filters etc. Harvey's mechanic that backhoe should be greased every week and a half to two weeks not every 8 hours our maintenance operator was informed.

Water - some residents have experienced dirt in their tap water. This could be explained by a lack of water usage this winter. Screens in the pumphouse were cleaned out within the last couple weeks.

The following repairs were carried out to the dump truck through Coish's Trucking:

- Grease, Oil and Filter
- Changed the fuel filters, coolant filters and compressor filter
- Tightened U bolts in rear.
- Checked out truck
- Replaced the muffler and muffler straps.
- Checked the gear oil in the rear end and gear box.
- Adjusted the brakes
- Topped up all fluids.
